

Y ou have arrived at the top of the keep. Above you, there are still 10 meters of wooden framework. The keep is made of four rooms on top of one another, and the walls become less thick as you go up, going from 3 metres to one metre.

From this space you have a clear view to the Alps, the Jura and the Moléson.

In 2010, the Oron castle won the Vaud Canton Heritage Prize which is awarded by Retraites Populaires. The prize money received made it possible to fund a share of the works which led to the public access to the keep in 2012.
