Castle Oron The Hunting Room



This room, which was restored in 2010, contains a rare panorama painted on paper at the beginning of the 19th century. The panorama displays a nice hunting scene. Through the centuries this room was used in several ways: as a bedroom for the paymaster during the era of the bailiffs, as a summer dining room, and as a bedroom during the Gaïffe family's occupancy.
