

On the wall opposite the windows, four oil paintings by Clessinger, with a dedication to Adolphe Gaïffe. Some very beautiful French inlaid pieces of furniture decorate this room, in which ladies of the castle enjoyed having tea.

Before the 18th century remodeling, this sitting-room and the Bernese sitting-room were probably only one room. This space was then called the arms hall.
